As we celebrate our Church year, we kindly remind parishioners that the Ukrainian Catholic Church observes several important fasting periods. While joyous celebrations like weddings are cherished events, we encourage families planning a marriage to be mindful of these sacred times. Traditionally, weddings are not celebrated during the more solemn fasting seasons, such as the Great Fast (Lent), as this period is dedicated to deep spiritual preparation and penitence. Additionally, Wednesdays and Fridays throughout the year are days of abstinence from meat in our tradition. Regarding other fasting periods, such as the Nativity Fast (Pylypivka), the Apostles' Fast (Petrivka), and the Dormition Fast (Spasiwka), these are also times of spiritual focus. While less stringent than the Great Fast, the spirit of self-denial and prayer is still encouraged. In specific circumstances, and with pastoral discretion, our Bishop may grant a dispensation for the celebration of the Holy Mystery of Matrimony during these periods. We encourage those discerning marriage to speak with our parish priest well in advance to discuss suitable dates and any potential need for a dispensation. This ensures that the celebration of this beautiful Sacrament aligns respectfully with the spiritual rhythm of our Church. May God bless all those preparing for the Sacrament of Matrimony!

VATICAN CITY (OSV News) - Just as we wouldn't leave newborns without clothes or food, we cannot leave them without faith and baptism, Pope Leo XIV told parents of children he baptized in the splendour and beauty of the Sistine Chapel January 11. The tradition of baptizing children of Vatican employees started in 1981 with St. John Paul II. Pope Leo baptized 20 children on the [feast of the Baptism of the Lord](#). "The children you now hold in your arms are transformed into new creatures," the pope told parents and godparents gathered for the ceremony in the breathtaking interior of Michelangelo's chapel. "Just as they received life from you, parents," he said, "so now they receive the meaning to live it: faith." In seeking good for our children, we wouldn't "leave newborns without clothes or food, waiting for them to choose how to dress and what to eat as adults," would we? the pope asked. Addressing the gathering as "Dearest ones," the pope said that if "food and clothing are necessary for life, faith is more than necessary, because with God life finds salvation."
